



# Ford Focus 00-04 Double DIN Fitting

Replace a standard or single DIN radio for a Double DIN radio

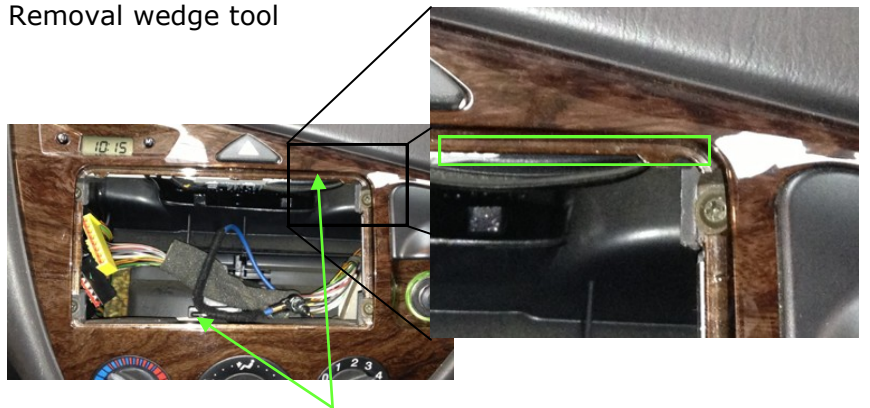


What you need...

- 50-693 Double DIN fitting brackets
- 29-606 Steering control interface
- 29-025 Steering control adapter lead
- 85-207 Removal wedge tool



With the original radio removed, you can see 2 strips top and bottom where the original radio was located.



These need to be carefully filed away to allow a Double DIN head unit to fit.



Attach the fascia brackets to the double DIN head unit. Fixing screws are supplied with the fascia. You will not need the cage or trim that came with the head unit. Push the head unit in part way to check the fit, it may be necessary to file the hazard switch housing for a good fit.



With a 29-606 and a patch lead to suit the make of head unit, connect and test the operation of the steering wheel controls.

With everything working, push the head unit into place.

The fascia brackets will clip in holding the head unit in place.
