




Attention! Let the vehicle sit with the key out of the ignition for a few minutes before removing the factory radio. When testing the aftermarket equipment, ensure that all factory equipment is connected before cycling the key to ignition.

## **DASH DISASSEMBLY**

- **1.** Unclip and remove the a/c vent trim panel surrounding the radio. (Figure A)
- 2. Remove (6) Phillips screws securing the radio/display. Slide the radio/display out, then unplug and remove the radio/display.

**Note:** The antenna cable is connected down lower by the floorboard.




### **KIT ASSEMBLY**

- Secure the *radio brackets* to the radio using the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A)
- 2. Secure the *pocket* to the bottom portion of the *radio brackets* using the (4) #8 x 3/8" Phillips screws provided. (Figure B)
- **3.** Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna connector in the dash and complete all necessary connections to the radio.

**Note:** The amplifier turn-on wire must be tapped into the factory radio harness. Locate pin-23, a **Pink** wire, in the 24-pin harness.



- **4.** Secure the radio assembly to the dash using the factory screws.
- **5.** Attach the (4) panel clips provided onto the radio trim panel, then clip the radio trim panel onto the radio assembly. (Figure C)
- Reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly to complete the installation.
