



### **TOOLS REQUIRED**


- Panel removal tool Phillips screwdriver
- 10mm socket wrench

Attention! Let the vehicle sit with the key out of the ignition for a few minutes before removing the factory radio. When testing the aftermarket equipment, ensure that all factory equipment is connected before cycling the key to ignition.


## **DASH DISASSEMBLY**

- 1. Unsnap and remove the dash panel below the radio including the vents. (Figure A)
- 2. Remove the shaded (2) Phillips screws and (1) 10mm bolt under the radio, unsnap and remove the radio and dash panel together. (Figure B)
- **3.** Remove (4) Phillips screws to remove the radio from the dash panel.



## **KIT ASSEMBLY**

- Attach the radio trim panel to the factory dash panel with (2) of the factory screws.
- 2. Attach the **radio brackets** to the radio using screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A)
- **3.** Attach the radio assembly to the factory dash and secure using the (2) top factory screws.
- 4. Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna connector in the dash, and complete all necessary connections to the radio. Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the radio for proper operation.
- **5.** Secure the entire assembly into the dash using (2) factory screws.
- **6.** Reassemble the dash.
