


- Panel removal tool Phillips screwdriver
- 10mm socket wrench Cutting tool


DASH DISASSEMBLY

- 1. Unclip and remove the factory radio trim panel including the a/c vents. (Figure A)
- 2. Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the radio. Slide the radio out, then unplug and remove the radio. (Figure B)



KIT PREPARATION

- 1. Cut the marked area in the dash cavity. (Figure A)
- Remove (1) 10mm nut holding the area previously cut in step 1 to remove the cut-out area.
- **3.** Snap the **radio trim panel** into the factory trim bezel from the back side of the bezel.



KIT ASSEMBLY

- 1. Secure the **radio brackets** to the radio using the screws supplied with the radio. (Figure A)
- 2. Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna connector in the dash and complete all necessary connections to the radio. Test the radio for proper operation.
- 3. Secure the radio assembly to the dash using the factory screws, then reassemble the dash in reverse order of disassembly to complete the installation.
