



NOTE: Refer to the instructions included with the aftermarket radio.


# **Dash Disassembly**

- Unclip and remove the trim panel from around the climate controls. (Figure A)
- 2. Remove (2) Phillips screws securing the climate controls then unclip and remove them. (Figure B)
- 3. Unclip and remove the a/c vents above the factory radio. (Figure C)
- 4. Remove (4) Phillips screws securing the radio then unclip and remove the radio. (Figure D)
- Unclip the four plastic panel clips from the factory radio and place them onto the radio trim panel.







## Kit Assembly

## **Double DIN radio provision**

- Attach the brackets to the radio with the screws included with radio. (Figure A)
- 2. Locate the factory wiring harness and antenna plug in the dash and make all necessary wire connections to the radio.
- **3.** Mount the new radio assembly into the dash.
- **4.** Attach the (4) factory panel clips to the radio trim panel.
- 5. Reassemble the dash in the reverse order of disassembly using the radio trim panel.
