

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


Toyota Hilux 2005-2010

- 1. Remove the (3) climate control knobs by pulling straight outward. (Figure A)
- **2.** Remove (1) Phillips screws from behind the center knob.
- **3.** Unclip and remove entire trim panel surrounding the radio. (Figure B)
- 4. Remove (4) 10 mm bolts to securing the radio. (Figure C)











DIN head unit provision


- 1. Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.
- Slide the mounting brackets onto the sides of the radio housing until the side clips engage. (Figure A) *Note:* Tabs are marked left and right.
- Slide the DIN cage into the radio housing and secure by bending the metal locking tabs down. (Figure B)
- 4. Slide the aftermarket head unit into the cage and secure. (Figure C)
- 5. Snap the trim plate into the radio housing. (Figure C)
- 6. Reassemble dash in reverse order of disassembly.



ISO DIN head unit provision

- 1. Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash. Re-connect the negative battery terminal and test the unit for proper operation.
- Slide the mounting brackets onto the sides of the radio housing until the side clips engage. (Figure A) *Note:* Tabs are marked left and right.
- 3. Mount the ISO brackets to the head unit with the screws supplied with the unit. (Figure B)
- Slide the head unit into the radio opening until the side clips engage. (Figure C)
- 5. Snap the trim plate into the radio housing. (Figure C)
- 6. Reassemble dash in reverse order of disassembly.
