



Before installing

- 1. Make sure the ignition supply to the vehicle is turned off
- 2. Ensure the head unit is removed from the car ensuring easy access to the connections on the back of the original unit.

Connecting the Jack lead

- 1. Connect the Ducato specific connector (Red Connector Plug) to the vehicles original radio connector
- 2. Connect the 3.5mm jack plug to the back of the Sony 8050 (Labelled REMOTE)
- 3. Connect the ISO radio lead (Supplied with the Sony radio) to the corresponding female ISO connections from the back of the radio.

Programming the Steering Wheel Controls




1. Select SETTINGS from the main menu



3. Turn DEMO off and scroll down



2. Select GENERAL from the settings menu



4. Select STEERING CONTROL






5. Select CUSTOM function




7. When selected the icon will highlight white



9. A yellow outline will show around the function when it has been programmed



11. If you make a mistake you can use the clear button to reset the function



6. PRESS and HOLD the desired function you wish to program



8. Press and hold the corresponding button on the steering wheel controller



10. When you have finished assigning buttons use the back arrow to save functions

Test the Sony unit fully, ensuring all the steering wheel control functions are working properly before fixing the new head unit into the vehicles dashboard.
